Description

- Participate as a Special Structural Inspector on a variety of large and small whole building and building component project sites that range across most market sectors, building occupancies, and material types throughout the Phoenix Metro area.
- Position will be focused on doing site inspections for projects where MBJ is the Engineer of Record (EOR).
- Record keeping and report writing to document site inspections performed and track discrepancies.
- Position would also include assisting the project engineer with review of shop drawings and answer Requests for Information (RFIs) from the general contractor.

Required Qualifications

- Special Inspector should be ICC certified in all of the following disciplines – Reinforced Concrete, Structural Masonry, Structural Welding, and Structural Steel and Bolting.
- City of Phoenix Certified Structural Inspector, or qualifications to get certified.
- Minimum of 3 years of Special Structural Inspection experience.
- Travel to various project sites is a required part of this position.
- Academics: Associates or Bachelor's Degree in engineering, construction management, or related field is preferred but not required.
- Working knowledge of reading construction documents.

Desired Qualities

- Strong working knowledge of building codes, structural systems, construction details, and procedures.
- Ability to work with the design team to anticipate, identify, and resolve problems.
- Ability to exercise judgment and discretion, and to set priorities to manage competing demands for multiple project inspections.
- Jobsite safety is a high priority and employee may be requested to attend OSHA safety course.
- Use of Microsoft Word, Excel and Bluebeam is required. Ability to use Autodesk Revit is helpful.
- Strong written and verbal communication skills.
- Ambition to participate and engage with industry groups, as a representative of MBJ.
